As, the first recipient of the United International Pictures and WFTV's Directing Change Award, she was mentored by director Roger Michell (Notting Hill, Changing Lanes, Venus) on the screen adaptation of Ian McEwan's *Enduring Love* (Daniel Craig, Samantha Morton). Shortly after she won a BAFTA for *Dawn* and collaborated with director, Geoffrey Smith on the Emmy award winning, *The English Surgeon*. Shreepali's most recent project is *The Crossing*, a multi-screen film installation on trafficking produced in collaboration with Oscar winning actress Emma Thompson. More recently she has been combining her filmmaking practices with academic research into the application of creative technology (sound and vision) at the Cambridge School of Art.
