ORIGINAL WORK:

Number One Special - A short play about a romantic liaison gone murderously wrong, performed at the Awkward Dating short play showcase in Glasgow.

The Love Train - Feature film about the birth of the Irish Women's Liberation Movement in the 1970s, and their famous contraceptive heist.

Tangled Web - 5 x 60' TV crime drama about the murky world of cyber crime.

Life and Death in Atlantis - Stage play. Viktor Ullmann wrote his last works in a concentration camp, before he was killed in Auschwitz. His son Johannes escaped Nazism as a child on the Kindertransport, and spent the rest of his life in a mental hospital in Surrey. This play tells their stories, interwoven with Viktor Ullmann's music.

The Old Songs - Tragicomic TV musical. Traditional Welsh stories are rewoven in modern day Swansea when a young heroin addict finds a guitar that grants her mythical power.
